Dear Mr. Matri:

The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has received and reviewed documentation detailing the outcome of remedial actions taken subsequent to a release of regulated substances from the above-named facility. Your release was confirmed on July 23, 1991. Your written submission, dated February 16, 2005, identifies each of the specific regulated substances involved in your release and subsequent cleanup.

Our review confirms you have attained your selected cleanup standard for each of the identified regulated substances. Specifically, the statewide health standard has been attained for toluene, ethylbenzene, xylenes, naphthalene, isopropylbenzene, and total Lead (Pb) in soil media. Site-Specific Standards have been attained for benzene, methyl tertiary-butyl ether, 1,2-dichloroethane, and 1,2-dibromoethane in soil media. The statewide health standard has been attained for toluene, ethylbenzene, xylenes, isopropylbenzene, 1,2-dibromoethane, and dissolved Lead in groundwater. Site-Specific Standards have been attained for benzene, naphthalene, methyl tertiary-butyl ether, and 1,2-dichloroethane in groundwater. The Department recognizes attainment of statewide health and site-specific standards for groundwater from the eight most recent calendar quarters of groundwater monitoring. The numeric site-specific standard can be obtained from the one-sided 95 percent upper confidence level of the mean for the groundwater contaminant data at point of compliance monitoring well MW-9.



You have also complied with the procedural requirements of the Department's Corrective Action Regulations as promulgated under the Pennsylvania Storage Tank and Spill Prevention Act. The relief of liability for attaining this cleanup standard is set forth in Chapter 5 of the Land Recycling and Environmental Remediation Standards Act of 1995.
